The University of Mary's Welder Library participates in local, regional, and national networks and provides access to over 75 million volumes. The Welder Library seats 204 students, has 30 computer workstations, and currently has approximately 50,000 print volumes, more than 300,000 eBooks, over 3,000 multimedia items, and databases providing access to over 40,000 journals. Materials are accessible through an online catalog. Welder Library provides free interlibrary loan services for faculty and students that offers access to local, regional, and nationwide library collections. The Welder Library subscribes to an array of nursing oriented online databases to support instruction and research. Interlibrary Loan (ILL) supports the educational, research, and scholarly activities of University of Mary students, faculty, and staff by obtaining research material not owned by the Welder Library. The Welder Library has a highly responsive and vigorous ILL program. Nearly all media including print, digital books, and periodicals are available by request through ILL. The Welder Library ILL program is ILLIAD, a subsidiary of OCLC.
