TESTING CENTERS

DSST is offered at the University of Mary's campuses in Bismarck (main campus) and Fargo, ND. Visit the DSST website to locate other testing centers near you.

Prior to taking the exam, contact your advisor to find out which DSST site number you should enter as

the score recipient. This ensures that an official copy of your transcript will be delivered directly to the University of Mary site nearest to you. If this is not done, you will have to request an official transcript and DSST charges \$30 for each official transcript.

SCORE DIFFERENCES (*)

A new score scale was introduced in 2008 for 15 of the DSST exams. These exams have score ranges of 200 to 500, with 400 being the required passing score.
